How it all works

The Process



1 Discuss and tell us what you want

We'll start by discussing with you everything you want for your stone. We'll draw a basic outline and make a list of your preferences and requirements.

This usually takes around an hour



2 Assigning a mason / receiving quote

Next, we will assign you the correct mason for your bespoke work, and ask them to provide us with an estimate for your stone.

This usually takes two to three weeks



3 Review, Revisions & Sign off

Once you accept the quote and pay the deposit, your mason will provide a detailed design mock-up for you to review and revise until such time as you are happy.

This usually takes two to four weeks



4 Production & Installation

Once you have approved the final design and paid the remaining balance, your mason will begin the production work and finally install the stone in situ.

This can take anywhere from four weeks up to twelve weeks (or more), depending on the specifics of your order.

Materials

Granite

For everlasting memorials

Granite is the hardest material we offer and is extremely durable. It is available in a range of colours. Polishing granite brings out the true natural beauty of this material. A range of finishes can be seen throughout this brochure including polished, honed and rustic effects.

Ornamentation is achieved by carving, etching or sandblasting.

Italian White Marble

The traditional memorial material

Sourced from Italy. Marble was once a very popular material and is known for its ease of carving. The appearance of this material has been synonymous with the splendour of memorial carvings for centuries. Ideally, marble should not be used near trees or in damp areas due to its porous nature which can cause it to attract mould or algae.

Stone

Materials such as nabresina, Portland stone and sandstone are mainly used in churchyards where their neutral tones are widely accepted.

Type of Memorials

Headstones

Headstones (sometimes called lawn memorials) are memorials where there is a stone at the head of the grave, usually attached directly to a base at the bottom. The rest of the grave is left uncovered by the memorial, showing the lawn.



Full Memorials

In addition to the main headstone and base, there is a full length memorial extending out from the base which covers the full length of the grave. This can be topped with a solid piece of stone, or coloured chippings, or any combination.
