JOB DESCRIPTION

Background

N. S. Wibberley Funerals was established in 2018 by Nicholas Wibberley, an experienced funeral professional in South London. The company prides itself on excellent funeral services and holds itself to the highest possible standards. Started originally as an online funeral service, NSW Funerals has grown in the past 4 years to an established and locally respected traditional funeral company, operating out of two funeral homes in South London and North Kent. We employ several staff, including funeral administrators in both branches, and a recently appointed funeral apprentice. Nicholas Wibberley has always been the 'standard bearer' for the funeral brand, conducting all the funerals and trying to work directly and personally with every family. However, the company has now reached a size where Nicholas is often not able to be at every funeral. We are appointing a new role of funeral operative to assist the team in the operational work which goes into every funeral, and to conduct the funeral which Nicholas is no longer able to conduct personally.

The Purpose & Role

Based across our two branches, the funeral operative/conductor will be responsible for working with the managing director and operations co-ordinator to ensure the funerals and general funeral operations are carried out to the highest possible standard. The main duties will include:

- Driving the private ambulance and collecting deceased persons from their place of death or local hospital/coroner mortuary.
- Assisting in the mortuary with the dressing and general preparation of the deceased (including encoffining).
- Transferring deceased from our Beckenham mortuary to our Catford branch ahead of chapel visits.
- Conducting funerals (funeral conducting will be split between post holder and Nicholas Wibberley).
- Occasional other ceremonial funeral work (such as vehicle driving or pallbearing).
- Occasional cover of funeral branch if the branch team are not available, to ensure continuity for our bereaved clients.
- Other operational funeral work as needed by the business.
